



CDECA MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR PROGRAM RECOGNITION

1. A provincial government accredits the program.
2. The federal government accepts a tax receipt for tuition paid in the program.
3. (a) Minimum 200 hours of in-class & field trip instruction (not including studios, practicums, project work) and/or (b) minimum 6 months for completion of a program.
4. Recognize on-line and correspondence courses based on 3 (b).
5. Recognize graduates of old programs no longer in existence based on comparison to comparable current programs.
6. Recognize graduates of Interior Design 3 year diploma or 4 year degree programs.
7. CDECA only recognizes programs at "Canadian-based institutions".
